A mechanical engineer will explain the testing needed to establish the defect and discuss alternative designs the manufacturer can implement to safeguard against inadvertent stove activations. The presentation will detail the claims that can be asserted against the manufacturer and arguments for rebutting the manufacturer's inevitable defense that the fire was the fault of the insured, their children, pets, or others.
