The suit claims that more than 20 defendants are responsible for the contamination and pollution of natural resources in and around the county.

The article also looks at guidance released by the EPA in August 2022 for public water systems to develop and maintain a service line inventory with their efforts to develop inventories and provide stats with needed information for oversight and reporting to the EPA.
