## Pennsylvania Republicans Rally Around Oh Mayoral Campaign

While Democratic mayoral nominee Cherelle Parker is heavily favored to win the general election in November, her former City Council colleague and Republican opponent David Oh is garnering support from the wealthy and powerful Republicans, who held a fundraiser for his campaign at the Union League on Tuesday.

## WFP Commissioner Candidate Removed From Ballot

Following a legal challenge from voters for his alleged failure to file campaign financial reports with city and state entities, Working Families Party (WFP) City Commissioner candidate Jarrett Smith was removed from the ballot. WFP City Council candidates survived legal challenges to their own candidacies.
