Tori focuses her practice on a wide array of complex commercial litigation matters including life insurance, financial services, and software implementation disputes. In the life insurance sector, she aids life insurance companies in litigating and fighting the fraudulent creation of multimillion-dollar life insurance policies that lacked insurable interest at inception—otherwise known as stranger-originated life insurance (STOLI). Tori also represents the families of insureds who were the subject of (and often the victims of) these investor-run STOLI schemes. She counsels her clients on an array of complex claims, including breach of contract, bad faith, fraud, and unjust enrichment in state and federal courts across the country.
