"People can agree or disagree [with the decision], but this is an expert tribunal, which heard evidence from the Commissioner, from Rogers, Shaw, Vidéotron, Bell, and Telus," said Michael. "People were cross-examined; they had documents, including those that contradicted what Bell and Telus said; they had expert reports—it's not like a Parliamentary committee which hears from a lot of people who don't know what they're talking about."
