Experience

Secured a favorable verdict for a golf club and hotel after a four-day jury trial in which the plaintiff, an LPGA professional whose membership was terminated after repeatedly violating club rules, sought \$6.8 million in damages for various business torts, breach of contract, and defamation. The trial proceeded only on the defamation claim after we obtained a partial directed verdict that disposed of the other causes of action. The jury awarded the plaintiff far less than a prior offer of judgment and after paying the defendants' costs, she was left with a four-figure award.
